## Report of Confirmation of EU REACH 22th SVHC

Industrial Solutions Company, Panasonic Corporation ("we") hereby report that, based on the information provided by our suppliers and the information on parts/materials used in those products, the products below contain only Pb(CAS No. 7439-92-1) of the 205 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) listed on the candidate list updated on January, 16, 2020 by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) above concentration of 0.1wt%.

(\*2) The view of the Electronic Components Industry is that "diboron trioxide ( $B_2O_3$ )", or "lead oxide ( $PbO$ ,  $Pb_3O_4$ )" in glass or ceramics are not Substances of Very High Concern. The industry also has the view that "complex oxides containing lead (lead titanium trioxide [ $PbTiO_3$ ], lead titanium zirconium oxide [ $(Pb_x Ti_y Zr_z)O_3$ ])" in ceramics are not Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC).
